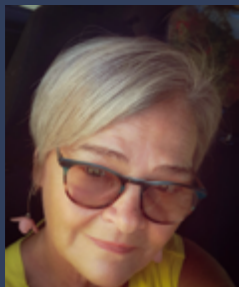

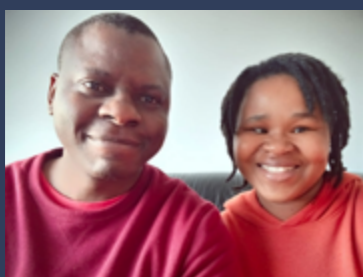

Once in a Blue Moon

When the moon is closest to the earth in orbit, it is called a perigee and the moon therefore appears thirty percent larger than usual. The Christian calendar depends on the phases of the moon to determine Easter or the Paschal Moon, as well as the Lenten moon.

In our unique South African context, load shedding coincided with the most wonderful view of our moon on the evening of the 31st of August. Our section of the city had a blackout and thus the moon became the best entertainment on a winter's night. We went outside and gazed up. Apparently, Saturn was also very close to the moon, although you needed a telescope to see it. A clever astronomer who had the camera lenses and telescopic attachments, managed to snap a photo of the event.

The apparent blue tinge of the moon could be atmospheric effects of water vapour but could also reflect some of the terrace elements of titanium oxide and iron on the moon itself, being made up of similar metals as the first 4 planets from the sun.

I have reconstructed an artistic version of the planet Saturn aligned with the Blue Moon this week. The moon photo I have used was taken by the Apollo 11 astronaut Michael Collins. While Buzz Aldrin and Neil Armstrong were bouncing on the lower gravity of the moon and planting the American flag, with "one small step for man and one giant leap for mankind," commander Collins remained on the service module Columbia in lunar orbit, ensuring the team had a way to return to earth!

When we are involved in ministry, there are moments that capture everyone's attention and seem more exciting. Yet, in my experience, it is

the diligence in the secret place of prayer that elicits beautiful memories and captures the awe of the moment. While some experience amazing miracles, reach the crescendos of a beautiful hymn, go to the far reaches of the earth, we can all orbit in prayer. We can take snapshots of God's vision of His creation to share with generations to come.

Prayer and journaling are a valuable resource in the kingdom of God. Keeping track of what God is doing in the earth is indeed a privilege and a joy!

This year the Lord spoke to my heart not to book too many travels as I have done the year before. Last year was amazing and exciting. This year I felt as if I had been grounded in a way! When my daughter told us she could visit in May, we had not expected it. We had prayed for three years to see her again after her time with her Christian dance company, Ballet Magnificat. Once, I had wept about it during a sermon on Sunday, much to my own embarrassment, but the congregation had graciously comforted me. Then it happened, and Cherie had to stay on for three months because of her visa application!

When God tells us to do something, we seldom understand the implications. We try to figure it out with our minds and reason away all the scenarios.

Being still before the Lord, finding Godliness with contentment is, indeed, great gain! Once in a blue moon, God may surprise you and reward you for all the sacrifices and secret services you have performed for Him and for others. You will be surprised by how beautiful the moment becomes, if you'd only take a moment and look up beyond the earthbound rituals, we call our lives.

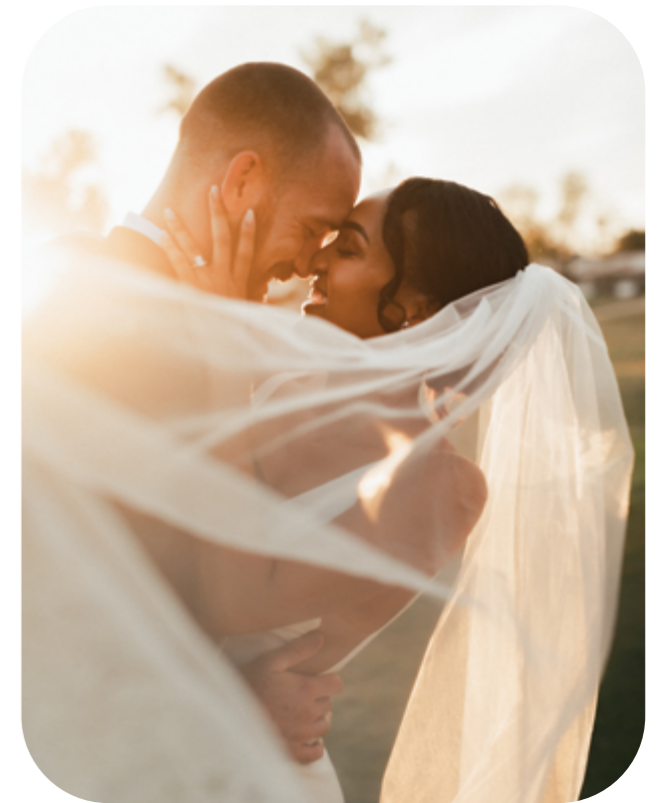
help and the righteous' s voices are bold and will be heard in the earth for change!

Gospel of the KINGDOM

Jesus Preached it!

Jesus preached the Gospel of the Kingdom of heaven. All his parables explained how that kingdom works.

All his disciples expounded upon that kingdom through their lives, miracles, sacrifices and letters to the early church.

When Jesus ascended, He spoke about things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

"The first four New Testament books are called the Gospels. "Gospel" is the Anglo-Saxon equivalent of the Greek evangelion, "good tidings" it means "good spell" (story), or perhaps "God's spell". There is, of course, only one Gospel. This Gospel is called the Gospel of God, of Christ, of the kingdom, of the grace of God, of His Son, of the glory of Christ, of our salvation, of peace, of the glory of the blessed God." From MBTC Life of Christ Manual.

Here are some forces that help us to go and preach the Gospel of the Kingdom to our generation.

1. Commission.

We have a commission to go and command to love from our King Jesus:

We are commission to go and commanded to love.

Mat 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

Mat 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Mat 28:20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Joh 13:34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

Joh 13:35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

2. Principles of the King.

The kingdom is empowered by the principles of the king as seen in His sermon on the Mount: the beatitudes give us the attitudes to be like Jesus: "The King's enunciation of the laws of His Kingdom. It is the means whereby the King has a kingdom, and rules it." From "the Life of Christ" by Dr Roy M. Gray. The first beatitude reflects the heart of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ:

"Mat 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

"A perfect statement of His own life. Humble birth, humble dedication in Temple, obedient to parents in Nazareth, meek submission to John's baptism, choice of lowly men as disciples, utter dependence on the word of God in the wilderness temptation, and refusal to adopt the grandiose schemes of the devil to further His earthly mission, conversation

with woman at the well contrary to proud attitude of Jews, submits to ill-treatment at Nazareth, compassion for multitudes, contact with a leper, eating with the downtrodden, denial of any power of His own, and on and on." From "the Life of Christ" by Dr Roy M. Gray, available as a full course from MBTC.

3. Righteousness

The force of righteousness helps people to access the kingdom of Heaven.

Gal 3:6 just as Abraham "BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS ACCOUNTED TO HIM FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS."

Just as Jesus spoke authoritatively so were they to speak in His name. This new kingdom is first of all "righteousness ... in the Holy Ghost" (Rom. 14.17). Those men are to chart the course of this new kingdom, in the power of the Holy Spirit. The kingdom of heaven is to interpret to the world the moral standards of life, teach men the will of God in the lives of the citizens of the kingdom (cf. Mt. 5.16,20, Col. 4.5 where those in the kingdom are to "walk" so as to be an example of godliness to "them that are without"

4. Peace.

The force of peace overarches all understanding and agendas.

Php 4:7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

5. Joy.

The strength of boldness and joy in the Holy Spirit and in believing Jesus' Good News is what gives us superpower to go continually.

Act 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Mat_13:44 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he

has and buys that field.

Neh. 8:10, "The joy of the LORD is your strength."

6. Repentance

The force of repentance and remission of sins through His blood reconciles us with God.

Mat 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Act 2:38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

7. Sacrificial Giving

The force of sacrificial giving and offering our lives as a living sacrifice propels the Gospel forward and helps to establish the kingdom of God in hearts and minds wherever we are sent.

Luk 8:1 Now it came to pass, afterward, that He went through every city and village, preaching and bringing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God. And the twelve were with Him,

Luk 8:2 and certain women who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities—Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come seven demons, Luk 8:3 and Joanna the wife of Chuza, Herod's steward, and Susanna, and many others who provided for Him from their substance.

8. Sent ones

Apostolic people understand that they are sent ones:

Apostles. Consult your dictionary. The Greek "apostolos" (G652) refers to a "delegate; specifically, an ambassador of the Gospel; officially a commissioner of Christ, with miraculous powers. An apostle is a messenger, one that is sent. (Strong's Concordance)

Joh 13:20 Most assuredly, I say to you, he who receives whomever I send receives Me; and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me."

Divine Agency of Church

Awaken to the deeper benefit of actively participating in a local church.

In our modern landscape, an intriguing yet troubling trend is emerging that could have far-reaching implications for the future of faith and community. A growing number of people are stepping away from traditional church settings, choosing instead to explore spirituality in isolation. While the quest for personal spirituality is undoubtedly important, and some churches justifiably a dead religion of works, abandoning the Church presents a dangerous predicament. becoming detached from a community of believers and the time-tested doctrines that have been the pillars of faith for centuries, individuals are left adrift in a sea of relativism, trying to discern truth without an objective point of reference. The most popular religion in America is not Christianity. Nor is it atheism, materialism, scientism, secularism or naturalism. It is "spirituality." A spirituality without God is a form of sorcery.

Let's never forget that the agency of the Church isn't anchored in human initiative or wisdom. Indeed, the Church's foundation isn't some influential mortal but Christ Jesus Himself. As it is

written in Ephesians 2:20, "Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone." He didn't merely draft a charter or devise a set of bylaws for His Church. Rather, He demonstrated an unparalleled love, John 15:13: "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." He sealed this love with His own blood, sanctifying the Church, as Ephesians 5:25-27 tells us: "Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy." Let's study some of the metaphors Jesus used to describe His heart for His Body, the Church.

The Church as a Temple of Living Stones
"...you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house..." (1 Peter 2:5). Imagine a glorious cathedral, not made of dead rocks and cold marble or moulded bricks (forced into a moulded prescribed form) but living stones—each unique and purposefully placed. This isn't a monument to be admired from a distance; it is a living, breathing organism dynamically adapting to the needs of its community. The term "Living Stones" is an oxymoron: stones are far from alive; they are stuck and immovable! What did Paul



mean by this statement? The essence of ecclesia is not a building for a building cannot get saved or save anyone; it is about the assembly and gathering! This gathering should always be Spirit-led. (Rom 8:14) As we continue to become more fit and agile in the way of the Spirit, we become like what John 3:8 describes: "The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit." Our meetings should never be monotonous or boring, or spectators looking at one person performing; no, like living stones, we all participate. (1 Cor 14:26) Whether a small gathering or a large one, there at that meeting, the living stones are moulded by the Holy Spirit to fit harmoniously together like the seamless robe of Christ. This is the heart of the living stone metaphor—In response to the Spirit's leading and finding Christ's redemptive solutions, we are woven into the tapestry of what every situation requires.

The Bride of Christ

The Church is also called the Bride of Christ (Revelation 21:9), illustrating the intimacy and covenant relationship between Christ and His people. Being envisioned as the potential bride of Christ signifies more than just a common association or mere relationship; it marks us as consecrated, set apart for a divine mission that transcends earthly understanding. This is why archaic yet profoundly meaningful terms like

"oneness" and "covenant" are employed to describe this sacred bond. It isn't a casual affiliation or a relationship of convenience; it's a sublime, eternal union with God that calls for our hearts' full, unreserved commitment. This union elevates us to a level of holiness and purpose, echoing the timeless virtues of fidelity and dedication that such a covenant entails.

A Royal Priesthood

"But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession..." (1 Peter 2:9). God's Kingdom is an incorruptible eternal (Ps 145:13), unshakable (Heb 12:28) form of GOVERNMENT. Standing before one of the most evil, corrupt, self-obsessed kings of all time, Daniel declares! "And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever." Daniel 2:44 (NKJV): The governments of man are temporary and fickle, based on the "arm of the flesh". This truth serves as a consolation as we daily read of governments of man failing us worldwide. When the King sanctions or calls a meeting, that meeting is governmental in nature. The GATHERING of BELIEVERS is a spiritual, heavenly-mandated governmental gathering where God meets with His representatives. Here, we are empowered to receive instructions for divine acts

of salvation that HEALS and sets people FREE! When we gather in God's name, we are not merely a collection of individuals but a judicial parliament of heaven in sitting.

Salt and Light:

A Worldly Mission

"Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is fit neither for the soil nor for the manure pile; it is thrown out." (Luke 14:34-35) Our lives deposited and strategically positioned in societal moral-decaying hotspots halt decay and nurture righteousness, creating an alternative kingdom that defies the world's toxicity. As salt preserves and seasons, and as light dispels darkness, the Church's presence should produce a noticeable, transformative effect in the world. Mere philosophical discussions can't achieve this; it requires boots on the ground—salt making contact and light piercing through darkness. Be salt and light in your community by serving on existing structures, like the Ward Council, Community Police Forum, Clinic and Hospital Boards, Business Chambers, School Boards, and Sports Clubs. Commanded to Love, Commissioned to Go We're given a twofold mandate: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind" (Matthew 22:37) and "go

and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). The Church truly comes to life when it breathes in a rhythm of divine purpose! Just as our lungs inhale to absorb life-giving oxygen and exhale to remove what's stale, so the Church functions in a spiritual respiration of its own. When the Church inhales, it draws itself closer to God, engaging in communion and intimacy with the Divine. In this inward breath, the Church rejuvenates its spirit, renews its purpose, and refocuses its vision. However, the Church's breath isn't complete until it exhales. In exhaling, the Church extends its arms to the world, beckoning all to come and taste the richness of life in Christ. Just as the Apostles were commissioned to "go and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19), the Church exhales by actively sending its members as emissaries to invite every soul to become a follower of Christ. It's a clarion call that echoes through the corridors of time, space, and circumstance, imploring all to join this grand, eternal family.

Awaken, oh Church, your salvation and time of vindication is near!!

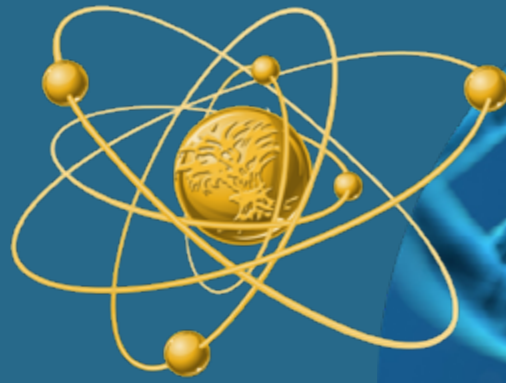

DNA of Harvester Churches

When you walk into a Harvester Reformational church you will find:

A friendly face greeting you at the door.

not be neglected and given mundane games to play to keep them busy, they will be given training in the Word from the start by a team of teachers with full time Bible college students as helpers.

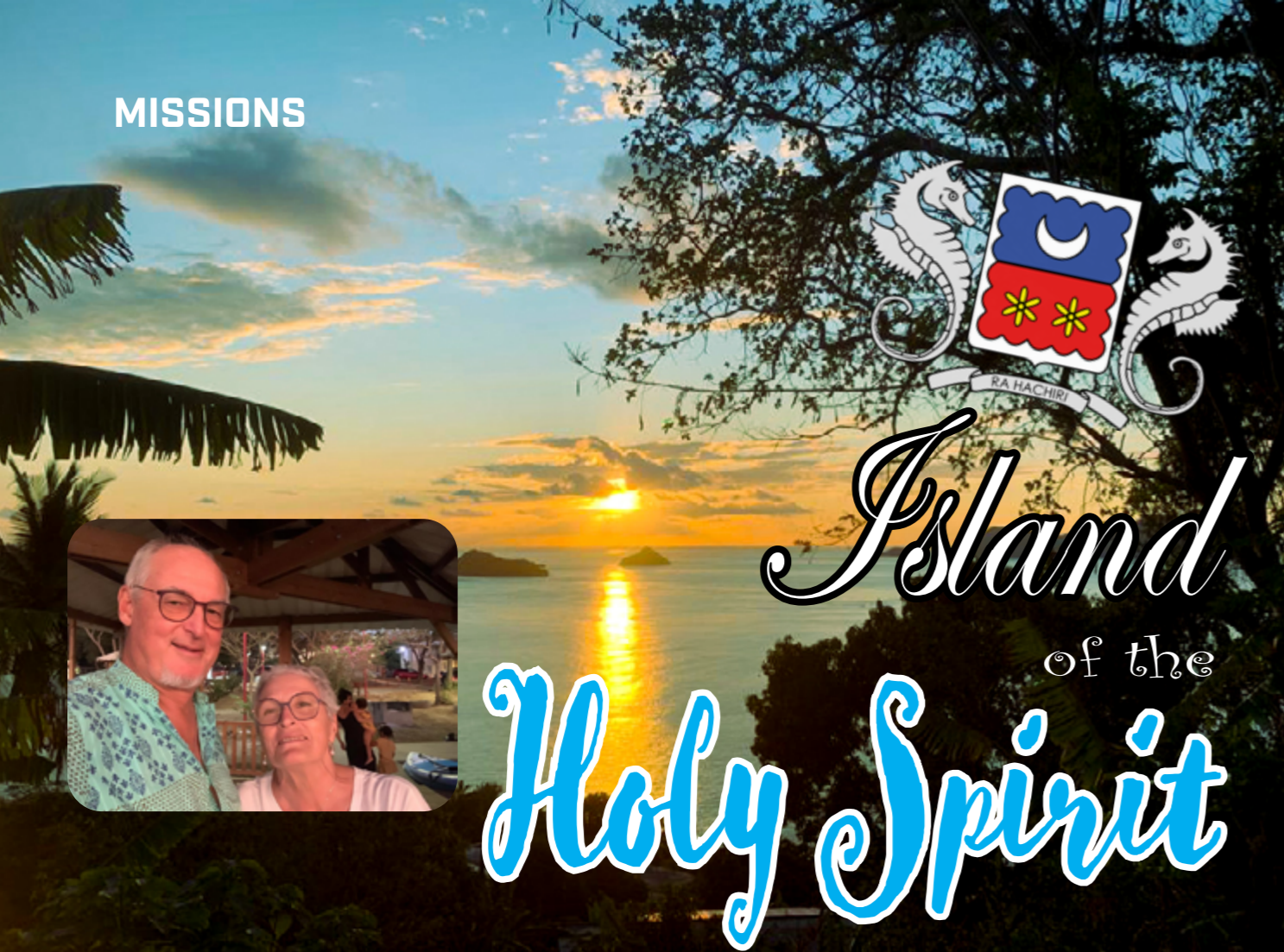
You won't find leaders who only care about numbers; they will contact you and walk a road with you.

I sit in the boarding room in Mayotte airport for a return to Paris, and tears come to my eyes as I am thinking of the beauty of our church in Koungou and the great valor of heart of its leaders. "Jehovah has done great things for us, we are happy."

To see how this local church accepted the preaching of Church reform and already made its transformation with the Holy Spirit's help in 18 months is wonderful. This little church became a model and a reference for Mayotte in terms of evangelization and the formation of Christ's disciples.

To live the fervour of the God's children in praise, worship, fellowship, in the seriousness listening to the Word and the consecration of adolescents in music and prayer, how not to be rejoiced!

Claire could give a moving testimony of one of the dramas of her life on the YouTube platform "Prières Efficaces", a story that has touched many people. In God's family, we are a great source of joy for one another.

Our implantation in Mayotte was made quite naturally. With Claire we are now members of the church of Koungou, 5 km from Mamoudzou, the main city of the department of Mayotte. At the same time, I am also registered on the Council of the Order of Physicians of the Island. We can say we put our suitcases there!

Today the three Apostles: Heather, Manda and I dedicated the first couple of shepherds of this church. The house's cells multiply and will be as many places of evangelization for this island which needs so much.

I preached on how to flee sin and encouraged

the sanctification of the members, this narrow way so fundamental.

Then, with the help of Madame Guyon's writings, a teaching on how to meet God within ourselves in peaceful meditation encouraged us all. Other ministries are being prepared and will soon appear in the church.

Manila, June 2023

Manila is one of the most congested cities in the world. There are only single lanes in a city with a very large population. The only freeway goes to the airport. It is 34 degrees Celsius in June and it is the rainy season with heavy downpours and some typhoons. I mostly travel by taxi or bus but sometimes I use the motorbike taxi. Street people live and sleep on the sidewalks and the kids play in the streets. The dogs look forlorn and sickly. The people are poverty stricken. And yet there are great industries in the Barangays or suburbs. The TV in the hotel room only has three English movie channels, mostly horror or violent, and three English news channels. All the other channels are Philippine in Tagalog, their local language. My first ministry was in Bacoor, Cavite with Pastor Gil Pansoy. His cars were not available and I had to wait at the SM Mall for a while before he could get a taxi to come and fetch me. A taxi to Bacoor costs about \$35 (US) or



PP150 in their currency. Like most Asian people the Filipinos have beautiful straight black hair. Some ladies decide to die their black hair into white and it ends up in a yellow ochre look.

Filipinos are very friendly and hospitable. They also treat you with respect. They always welcome you, 'Mabuhay!'

The Chinese are constructing mile high apartments and business blocks all over the city. Japanese businessmen and sailors are everywhere. Australians love to be in Manila. The equitable weather is between 24 and 34 degrees Celsius throughout the whole year.

Although it is generally known as a poor country, the hotels, restaurants and bars, are constantly full of local people. They always address you as, 'Sir' or 'Madam'.

Faithful Philippine People

To go and preach to the poor is a command given by our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. It is not easy because there are no offerings. You raise the funds to go and to stay there. Thank God for faithful people who believe in what you are doing to support



a mission. I sell paintings, books, CD's and DVD's to help with expenses.' In every Word of God there is inherent power to fulfil it. If you do what it tells you God will help you to fulfil it. As you step out in faith God releases power to help you complete the task. Jesus and Peter walked on the stormy waves that threatened to drown them. It's impossible to walk on water. But they did. God made it possible. What it takes to connect to that supernatural power is faith. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. When you receive a word from God, faith is birthed in your heart to believe you can do it. Faith opens another dimension to you where you can see yourself doing what God commanded. Jesus said, 'I do nothing except what My Father shows me.' (John 5:19) To preach to the poor is an impossible task, but by faith it becomes possible. The poor cannot remunerate you for your service but God can! Once faith is released through action it draws the right kind of support to complete the mission. In doing His will we finish His work and speed up the return of Christ.

I travelled by bus from Buendia bus

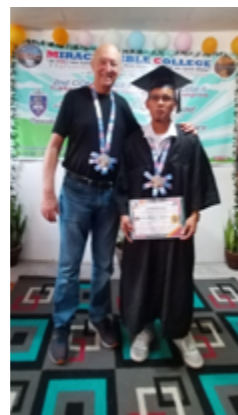

All the students couldn't make it because they did not have money for transport. They looked smart in their graduation gowns and top hat. I shared a message on II Timothy 2:15: 'Study to show yourself approved of God being a worker that is not ashamed but rightly dividing the Word of Truth being acceptable to God.'

We handed out the certificate to them and congratulated them before having a real Filipino lunch. All the banners, posters and certificates were created by Dave and Hilda. Their health business is doing well in six Barangays. The graduation in Coron Island, Palawan will be in July '23 and the next ones in Bacoor and in Davao City.

Apostle Dave and Hilda are doing well and are reaching many students with our Miracle Bible Training Centre material.

Introduction

I was sent by Harvester Reformational Church Birmingham to support Harvester Bangladesh in their ministry work. They are effective in reaching the Muslim community for Christ, plant house churches and teach new converts how to preach the gospel message to other people in their communities.

Friday 7th July

Flew from Birmingham to Dhaka
 Saturday 8th July
 I landed in Dhaka on Saturday morning where I met Mosharaf and Imran. We flew to Jashore and travelled to Harvester church in Khulna.

Sunday 9th July

We ministered at Harvester Church Khulna. I spoke on Isaiah 61:1-3 Jesus being anointed to heal the broken hearted, set the captives

free... God confirmed His word. I had a word of knowledge for a lady, that she struggled with depression and shared that she needs to renounce Hindu practices as it is a root issue.

God showed me for another lady that she had a difficult relationship with her father growing up. She confirmed this and said that he used to lock her outside the house and would not let her back in. I shared with her that God the Father does not treat her that way. That he always welcomes her into His presence.

5 people got baptised after the service.

Monday 10th July

We ministered to the school children at Harvester Church.
 I shared the story of the man that was healed by Jesus at the pool of Bethesda and we prayed for the children afterwards. One lady brought her son to be prayed for. She said that he often bashes his head against the wall and screams for 10 minutes at a time. God showed me that it was generational curse that came through Hinduism practices. She said her mum has similar issues to her son. Sadly she

was not willing to repent and let go of the Hinduism rituals. When we prayed for the boy he started manifesting and we bound the demons. We trust God for his full deliverance.

We prayed for a boy that had breathing problems, Apostle Mosharaf had a word that he should get rid of the necklace around his neck. After it was removed, we prayed for his healing.

Tuesday 11th July

We ministered at a house church in the Khulna area. There were about 15 people. I shared on Jesus being the way, the truth and the life and encouraged them to share this good news with unbelievers. We also visited a leader in the community. He has led many people to the Lord, but the Muslim extremists conspired against him and accused him of owing people money, which led to him going to prison for a year. He recently came out of prison and he asked for us to pray for him as he resumes his ministry work.

Wednesday 12th July
 We flew back to Dhaka and I spent some time with Imran. It was great to hear his

testimony on how God changed and restored his life. During our evening meal Imran shared that the place we will be ministering at the following day may be dangerous. The Muslim extremists previously told him that if he baptises people in that area then they would kill him.

Thursday 13th July

We travelled 4 hours North to minister to about 40 people at a house church. Imran shared the gospel message and I taught on the armour of God. We baptised 6 people, I thank God that He protected us, no extremists came to kill us.

Friday 14th July

It was time to fly back to Birmingham, I was ready to come home as I was missing my family. It was a pleasure to work alongside Mosharaf and Imran in the ministry and I hope to do so again soon.

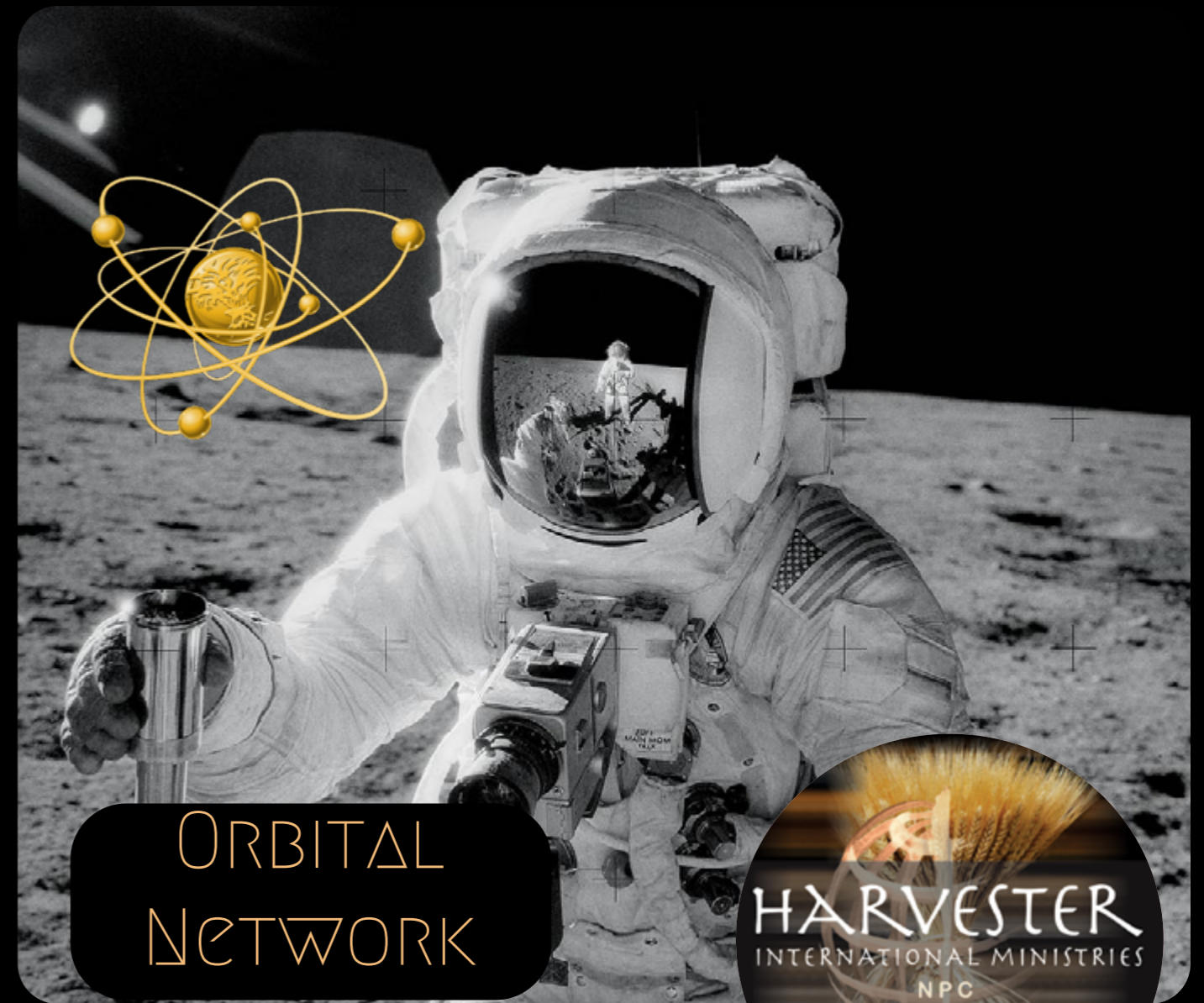

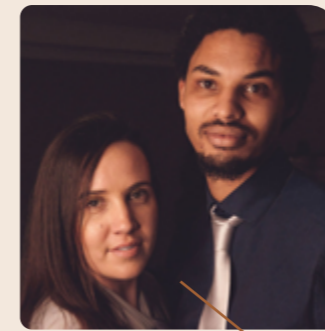

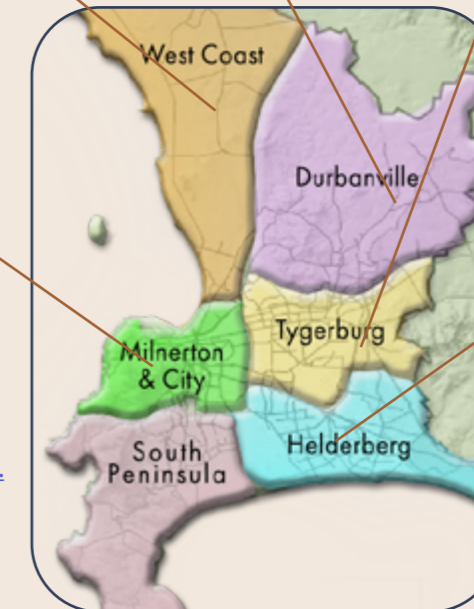

One morning I woke up with the number ten in my spirit. When God draws your attention to something, it normally stays with you for a long time and keeps coming up in conversations, signs during the day and insights from friends. Recently, some friends gave me a collection of Hebrew Alphabet letters, and the tenth letter is 'Yod.'

Yod is used to form all the other letters

As I meditated about ten in the Bible, and did a bit of research I found a very helpful site developed by Likutei Moharan, who shared some of the following valuable insights: "The tenth letter of the Hebrew alphabet is called "Yod" (rhymes with "mode") and has the sound of "y" as in "yes." The first dot with which the scribes first start

writing a letter, or the last dot that gives a letter its final form -- is a yod. (Likutei Maharan) Yod represents a dot, a divine point of energy. Since Yod is used to form all the other letters, and since God uses His Word, Jesus, as the building block of creation, Yod indicates God's omnipresence.

In fact, the word Ti' (yod) itself depicts something of the geometry of creation. It begins with the Yod itself, as a dot, and then moves downward, from the divine toward the created order to form Vav (the "hook" of creation). Finally, it moves

outward in the horizontal realm as Dalet (the "doorway" of creation). This can better be seen with the following illustration:

Since Jesus upholds the world by the Word of His power (Hebrews 1:3), and Yod is part of every Hebrew letter (and therefore every word), Yod is considered the starting point of the presence of God in all things - the "spark" of the Spirit in everything.



Three parts in one

He goes onto the comparison of the letter with the Trinity as well:

"The letter Yod is said to be composed of three parts: the upper prong (tag), a lower line curved downward, and a middle section. The upper tag points toward God, the lower line points toward earth, and the middle section holds the parts together in unity. Therefore, since it is three parts in one, Yod is not unlike the letter Aleph in alluding to divinity and picture Jesus as our humble Mediator before the Father,"

With regards to spirituality, 'Yod' resembles someone in submissive and humble prayer, with an arm or hand reaching toward heaven. The tag suggests a crown given to the humble.

Completion

The word is related in shape to 'chazah' or 'vision.' 'Yod' is the tenth letter and ten carries with it a value marking completion: The word Ti' (yod) means "arm" or "hand" and the numeric value is ten. Now ten is a number marking shelemut, or completion and order, as evidenced by the following:

- The base 10 number system is universal. Just

as Yod is part of all of the previous letters of the alphabet (as a component), so Yod is part of all of the numbers.

- There were ten things created on the first day and ten things created at the end of the sixth day of creation.
- There were ten generations from Adam to Noah, suggesting that the godlessness of those generations was made complete.
- There were ten generations from Noah to Abraham, suggesting that the godliness of those generations was made complete.
- According to Midrash, there were ten trials given to Abraham to demonstrate his merit as the father of the nations.
- There were ten plagues issued during the Exodus of Egypt.
- God gave us Ten Commandments.
- The "tenth part" shall be holy for the LORD (Leviticus 27:32).
- There are ten days of Awe - from Tishri 1 to Tishri 10, culminating in Yom Kippur, which

occurs on the 10th day of Tishri.

• Ten men are required for a 'minyan,' or complete quorum needed for Jewish corporate prayer
Yod is the first letter of the Divine Name YHVH (nin' and the name of the Savior of the world, Jesus (VIV), thus indicating its pre-eminence. It is also the first letter for four names given to the Jewish people:

- Ya'akov (or Jacob)
- Yisrael (Israel)
- Yehudim (Jews)
- Yeshurun (Jeshurun)

As the first letter of God's Name, Yod shows that He is Spirit, He is, and that from Him derive all other things by the power of His Word.

Shifting to occupation

As we are shifting into the occupation of our Church base of operations, we are nearing completion. That is why the letter 'Yod' resembling 'ten' is speaking to me at the moment. Jesus is the Word of God, the beginning of all letters is a 'Yod', and Jesus is the beginning and the end, the Alpha and Omega of it all. He is the author and finisher of our faith in all things, He is building His church, and He will complete it!

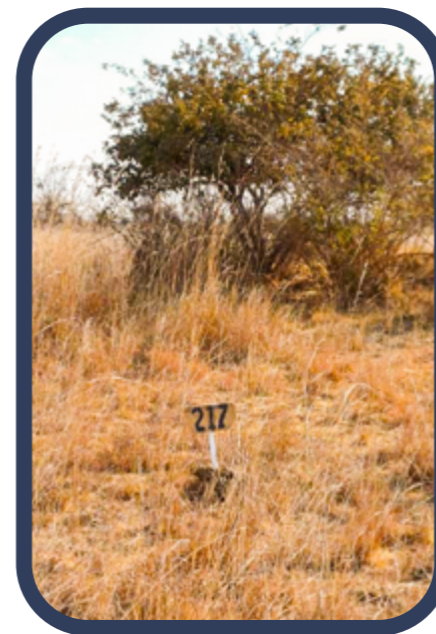

Teaching Children Psalms through the life of David

Children love a story! By using the Psalms in conjunction with David's life story, we get a look into what he really felt in situations, how he chose to trust & praise the Lord no matter what, learn of his awe for the Lord, amazement of His creation & how he held onto God's promises.

5 Tips when teaching children biblical truths using Bible stories:

1. Show the character (David) to be relatable e.g. dealing with siblings, parents; facing fears; being diligent and dealing with disappointments.

2. Give some historical context to the story

3. Show how the Old

Testament points to Jesus in the New Testament & is still relevant for us today

4. Use different methods of story telling: dress-up role play, pictures, puppets/ character impersonations, linking activities, quizzes& games to storylines

5. Use Questioning techniques

Using a few selected Psalms alongside David's story, not only gives the Psalms historical context but also shows how relatable it is for us now.

Children learn that Bible stories aren't just stories from the past but of real people who chose to trust God just like they do.
